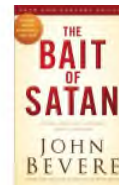

The special 6-week Sunday night Bible study series (facilitated by Pastor

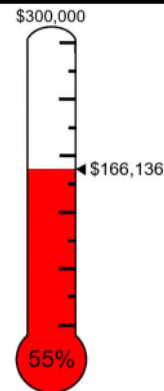

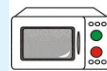
OPERATION love OUTREACH
