

We continue to prepare our hearts for Resurrection Sunday this month with a series of specially themed Wednesday evening WOW! classes that focus on "FREEDOM THROUGH THE CROSS!" We also have special "Family Fellowship" meals at 6 pm before classes each

Wednesday in March. *These are free meals, but we do accept donations to sponsor a veteran for the Honor Freedom Flight on May 5.* Discipleship classes are themed with special curriculum for each age group. Two and three year olds are celebrating "Jesus is Alive" with Bible stories, crafts and special snacks. The message that "Jesus is Risen" is coming alive for 4-year olds through Kindergarten as they do hands on activities that focus on the empty tomb! Grades 1-5 are participating in experiments that connect them to the Resurrection Story with their "Easter Science!" lessons. Middle school students are learning amazing truths with their series simply titled "Easter". High school youth are exploring "Encounters with Christ." with the Skit Guys. Pastor Mann is teaching on the topic "Freedom from Fear" with the adults.
